Dear Parent/Carer

From this half term, we are going to be introducing a Reading Reward system for Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils. Our aim with reading is for pupils to become confident, successful and independent readers alongside developing a love for reading and books. This can be achieved through regular practice and application of their phonic knowledge as they are learning to read and reading at home is a big factor in helping us achieve this aim.

Pupils will receive a hundred square which will be stuck in their planners. For every day that pupils read at home that week, they will gain a reading point on their hundred square which is a step towards receiving a reward. Reading points will be marked on the hundred square by teachers every week for the previous week.

Each time a pupil reaches a multiple of ten, they will receive 5 Achievement Points. If they reach 50 reading points, they will receive a prize and certificate in celebration assembly. If they reach 100 reading points, they will receive a second certificate in celebration assembly and be invited to attend a 'tea party' with a member of the Senior Team.

We would really appreciate your continued support with this by encouraging your child to read at home throughout the week and recording this in their planners.
