LITERACY

Key vocabulary:

Traditional tales expanded noun phrases
characters adjectives once upon a time
happily ever after

This term, we will be reading a range of traditional tales. We will be zooming in on their similar features and exciting use of adjectives. We will create a range of our own traditional tales using our own characters and plots!

We will also be creating a non-chronological report about dinosaurs. We will look at the different features of a report and the use of questioning.



Mathematics

Place value 50 addition subtraction
word problems length height weight
volume heavy lighter taller shorter

This term, we will continue to look at addition and subtraction within 20. We will then start numbers to 50 and one more and one less than these numbers, as well as how they are formed. We will also look at height, length, weight and volume. We will begin to compare heights and weights using vocabulary such as shorter, taller, heavier, lighter etc.



SCIENCE

Key Vocabulary:

This term, we will continue to learn about plants and names of a variety of plants and we will also think about plants we would find in our local area. We will label each part of a plant and discuss the function of each part. Also, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be able to identify a variety of different types of animals.
