Dear Parent/Carer

We hope all that you and your families are well. You will be aware that at present, whilst a direction of travel was announced by the Prime Minister recently, there remain many unanswered questions regarding the re-opening of schools in our country. When it happens, it is likely to be primary schools first, with certain year groups (Reception, Yr1 and Yr6) joining the pupils currently attending (the children of workers and vulnerable pupils). Whilst we also have a provisional date (Monday June 1st), so much still depends on what happens when other restrictions are lifted and, aside from that of course, a lot of further additional detail is still awaited.

What I can assure you of is that we are working through a host of possible scenarios, whilst maintaining the health and safety of our staff and pupils as the prime directive. When we know more, will we communicate it in a clear and timely manner.

This letter is primarily to inform you of an exciting appointment that we have made at Akroydon Primary Academy. From September 2020, our new permanent Principal will be Mrs Annie McNally.
