Term 5 update

It has been wonderful to welcome our pupils back since the wider reopening of schools on Monday 8 March. They have made us incredibly proud with their resilience and determination, adapting from remote learning back to the classroom with such enthusiasm.

You may be aware that we have increased sessions on wellbeing for all year groups and should you or your family need any additional support from us, please don't hesitate to contact our pastoral team who can offer advice and signpost you to local agencies, charities and support groups.

Before we close for the Easter break, I wanted to share a number of important updates that will be in place when pupils return to school on **Tuesday 13 April**.

In order to ensure the current government guidelines are followed to the best of our ability, there will be some slight changes to the staggered start and finish times of the school day.

- It is important that parents are clear about the time their child starts and finishes school and arrives promptly within the designated time slot
- We continue to request that all parents and carers wear a face covering during times of drop-off and collection
- Please use the open space on the opposite side of Grantham Road to wait should you be early for your allocated time; a member of staff will call you across when it is safe for you to enter
- Parents and carers continue to have the responsibility of social distancing when dropping-off and collecting their children

You will also notice from the table below that some of our teaching staff will be working with different groups for the summer terms of this academic year. These decisions are based on a variety of factors and have been made to carefully consider the support we can offer pupils as part of the recovery curriculum and how we can best help them prepare for the transition into the next phase of their education journey. Where changes are being made to staffing, time has been built into our next INSET day to ensure handover is of the highest quality.
