'Step 3' of the COVID-19 roadmap out of lockdown

As we begin to enjoy the freedoms of 'Step 3', with the opportunity to eat meals out as a family and visit places such as cinemas again, we did want to make it clear that many of the systems of control within schools remain the same as they have since wider reopening on 8 March.

- Pupils remain organised into 'bubbles', with staggered entry and exit times, as well as breaks and lunches facilitating this.
- Staff continue to wear face coverings in communal areas, as well as during drop-off, collection and when on break duties.
- Access to the school site remains limited to the end of the school day, with one adult asked to collect and a one-way system established through school
- A social distance of 2m is still adhered to by all adults in school and we ask that parents/carers continue to adhere to this measure.
- Pupils presenting with any of the three main symptoms of Coronavirus (a new, persistent cough, a high temperature, a loss of smell/taste) MUST NOT attend school and should self-isolate until receiving a negative PCR test.
- LFD tests are currently in use to identify asymptomatic cases of coronavirus. When someone presents with symptoms, they are required to have a PCR test and a negative LFD test will not be sufficient evidence to re-attend school in these cases.

Thank you for your continued understanding and support in applying these measures and keeping our community as safe as possible. Locally, there has been an increase in bubble closures recently, reminding us of the importance of staying vigilant and continuing to follow government guidance.
