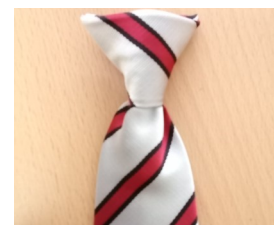

Big battery hunt



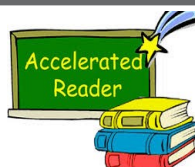
