

Mathematics


In maths, the children will be working on Number and Place Value. We will be recapping and learning the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). Our learning will include: place value, adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers and 2-digit numbers, and adding and subtracting 100s. You can help your child succeed and increase their confidence by practicing with them at home.

Key vocabulary:

Add altogether addition subtraction sum difference
