***Peace at Last* – by Jill Murphy**

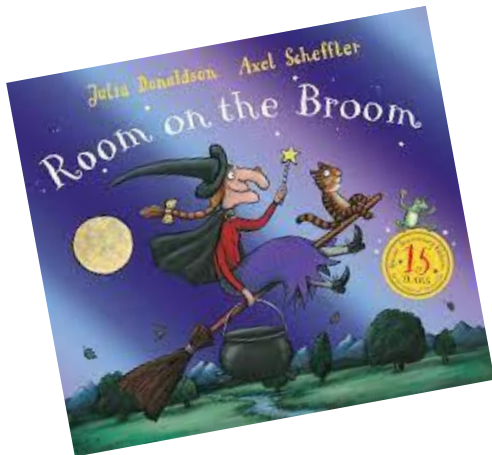
I liked all of it. The mum elephant needed some peace but the children kept her busy. The little elephant is little like me.

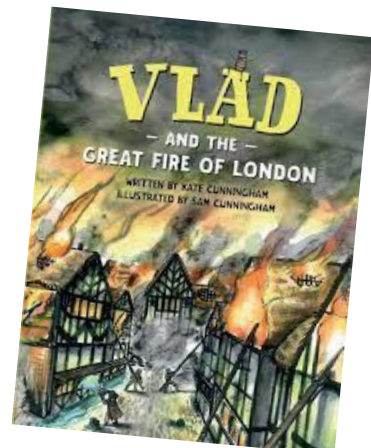

I enjoyed this book because it was about The Great Fire of London. Vlad and Boxtan escaped the fire but were scared on the way!



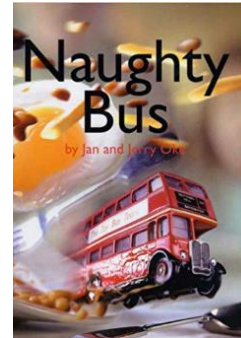

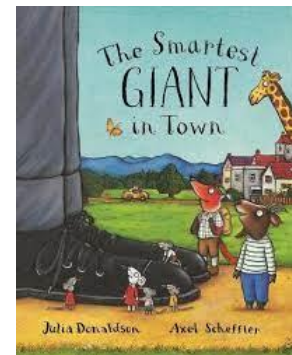

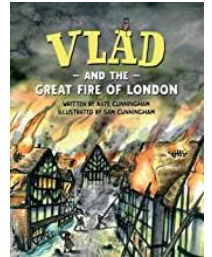
