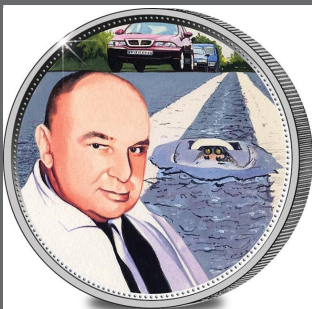

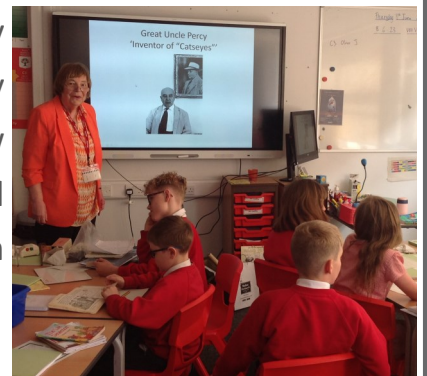
## Voices Together choir
