Years 5 and 6 will be taking part in live online chats with working scientists finding out about what they do, how they became scientists and taking part in an array of activities.



I'm a scientist is a student-led STEM enrichment activity. It connects school students with scientists through energetic real-time text-based chats. Our pupils will have the opportunity to pose questions to scientists who are actively working within science and engineering.





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Crest awards

The lab is open! It's fully stocked! Now it's time to get in there and earn our Crest award. Alberta Hamstein and our resident geckos are settled into their new home ready for our pupils to join them while completing this prestigious award.



Pupils will be given opportunities to apply science to their daily lives through the completion of eight specially designed workshops. These workshops will take place in our new science lab and, alongside their understanding of STEM, will also develop pupils' teamwork, problem-solving, creativity and communication skills.

British Science Week poster competition

The whole school will have the opportunity to enter the British Science Week Poster Competition.

The theme this year is 'Time'. Students could create a poster showing how a certain type of technology has changed over time, or even the advancement of time-telling technology itself. Budding poster makers could also go futuristic: show us how they think the world might look in years to come, or perhaps look at nature – lifecycles, lifespans, evolution and hibernation – nature is full of timely topics. British Science Week 2024 marks the Week's 30th anniversary, with the inaugural celebration happening in 1994. Students could think about scientific innovations since then, or explore 1994 itself – what was life like 30 years ago?

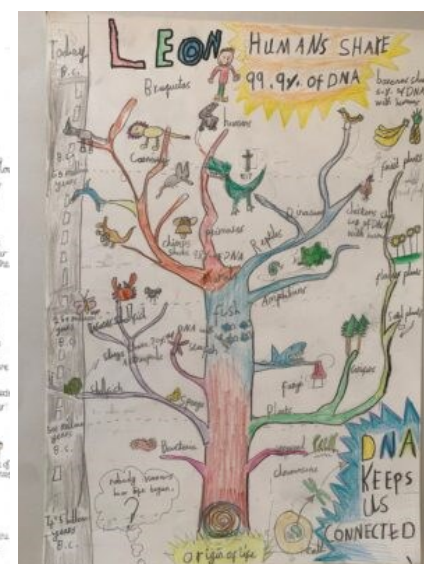
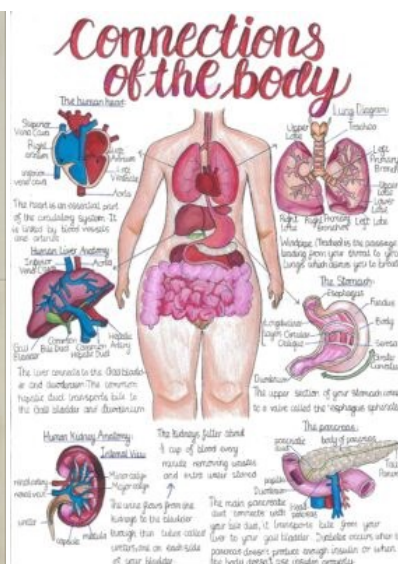
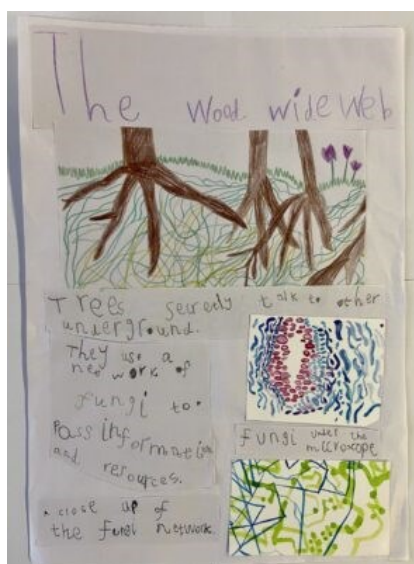
