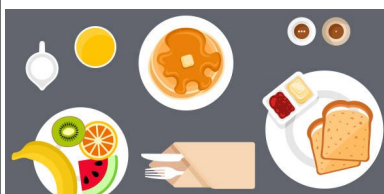
Year 5 are creating artisan style products to sell at the fair. If you have any glass jars (with and without lids) or empty candle pots which you could donate, please bring them into school early next week.

## Forest School

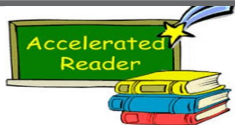
In Forest School this week, Birch Class have been exploring seed dispersal using dandelion clocks. They have searched high and low for minibeasts and planted teasels along the willow
